

When the Gloria is not sung during Mass the "Ite Missa Est" is repalced by "Benidamus Domino"










When priest begins "in the name of the Father..." choir chants the "Introit"

Then immediately following begins the "Kyrie"




After the Consecration by the Celebrant a Hymn is sung

At the "Pater noster."




Before the "Agnus Dei."







After the Choir receives communion they chant the **Communion Verse** (proper of the day) followed by a **Hymn**







